Aubrey is a outgoing child who loves singing, dancing, and playing with her older sister. She is the life of the party and loves going on adventures with whomever she can convince to come along.

During pregnancy we found out Aubrey had congenital CMV (Cytomegalovirus) and knew there would be complications after her birth including but not limited to hearing loss since CMV is the leading non genetic cause of hearing loss. Although she passed her newborn hearing screen, 1 month later they started to see some hearing loss in her right ear. After focusing our energy on physical therapy to help her overcome a large delay in gross motor skills, at 16 months we discovered she had unilateral severe/ profound sensorineural hearing loss in her right ear. Two day after she got her Ponto hearing device she stood for the first time and two months later, at 19 months old. she walked!


We found Desert Voices through a friend right before Aubrey turned 2 and it has been the biggest blessing to our entire family. Her vocabulary and speech have flourished in the Parent Coaching sessions where she worked with a listening and spoken language specialist and we learned strategies to support her speech and language at home. She started the jumpstart classes in the fall and quickly advanced to the toddler class where she is not only continuing her work with her speech but also working on her auditory and listening goals. Her developmental delays in her first 19 months have left her inexperienced with self regulation of her emotions, behavior, and feelings. Desert Voices has presented her with many opportunities to improve her social emotional skills as she participates in various learning activities with her classmates.

Everyone at Desert Voices is absolutely wonderful and have provided such a loving and supportive learning environment for not just Aubrey, but our whole family.
